1 RULES

All races will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

Appendix T Arbitration, modified so that an Arbitrator may form part of a subsequent Protest Committee, applies.

Australian Sailing Special Regulations of Part 2 Off The Beach Boats apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

All competitors shall be members of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing and financial members of the Tasmanian Sharpie Class Association.

All entries for the series shall be via the online entry accompanied by the prescribed fee and be lodged with the Organising Authority by 1600 hours on Friday 10 December 2021.

Late entries will be available up to 16 December on payment of an additional fee of \$20.

The entry fee for the Kangaroo Cup and Tasmanian Championship Part 1 will be \$100. Part 2 will be conducted separately in 2022.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the OTB training centre from 09:00 on Saturday 18 December and will also be published on the RYCT/OTB website.

5 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS/SIGNAL MADE ASHORE

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the OTB Centre.

Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagmast at the OTB Centre.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

No warning signal will be made after 1600 on Sunday 19 December 2021. There will be no more than five races each day.

7 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the Derwent River between Battery Point and Long Point.

8 COURSES

The courses will be triangle, windward/leeward as per the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

- There will be a maximum of eight races. A minimum of two races will constitute a series.
- If fewer than six races are completed a boat's score will be the total of her series scores.
- If six or more races are completed a boat's score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst score.

10 PRIZES

The winners of this series will be inscribed on the Kangaroo Cup board.
There will be other prizes as determined by the Organising Committee.

11 ENTRY DISCLAIMER

It is the competitor's decision to enter an event or to start and continue in any race. Attention is drawn to RRS 3 Decision to Race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in the Event competitors shall indemnify the Organising Authority, the host sailing club, their officers, members, servants and agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the event.

The Organising Authority, the host sailing club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the event or howsoever arising in connection with the event.

Entrants are required to comply with all COVID-19 related restrictions as in force at the time of racing.

12 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000.
