

Terms & Conditions

1. The visitor has provided his/her personal details and has requested the RYCT accommodate the vessel for which he/she is lawfully authorised to enter into an agreement.
2. Upon the execution of this agreement and prior to the commencement Arrival Date, the applicant shall provide valid credit card details as specified in Section 3.
3. The RYCT may at any time increase the marina or mooring fees without notice.
4. In principle, this Agreement will commence on the Arrival Date and will expire on the Departure Date.
5. Requests to extend occupation of the marina or mooring on a casual basis must be made via the RYCT Office. All requests will be considered on a subject to availability basis.
6. The visitor acknowledges by entering into this Agreement that he/she has examined and satisfied him/herself as to the condition and suitability of the marina berth or swing mooring, including but not limited to pontoons, after-hours access, and provision of standard electricity and water (if applicable), for the visitor's intended purpose, and the visitor will use the intended berth or mooring at his own risk. The visitor has not relied in any way on the RYCT's skills and judgement.
7. Noise must be kept to a minimum at all times and vessel occupants will use discretion when operating audio equipment in order to avoid annoyance to others. Disorderly or offensive conduct is not permitted at any time within the RYCT.
8. Any dinghy must be stored on board and not left in the water or at the berth unless a designated area has been set aside for which a charge may be made.
9. The RYCT will not permit commercial operators to enter into a casual berthing agreement.
10. The visitor shall keep and maintain the vessel and its equipment, including ropes and fenders, in good working order and condition.
11. It shall be the responsibility of the owner to provide his/her own mooring lines and warps to moor the vessel in a proper and seamanlike fashion.
12. The visitor shall operate and maintain the vessel with due care and diligence.
13. Any collision or damage to any part of the Marina or other boats must be reported to the General Manager within 24 hours. The Club shall not be liable to the applicant for the care or safety of the applicant's boat or damage to the boat or any person associated with the boat.
14. The boat must be registered and insured with \$10 million public liability. Proof of insurance must be provided to the Office before arrival.
15. Dogs are not permitted on the marina at any time except when under effective control on a lead whilst in transit to or from a vessel. All dog waste must be cleaned up immediately by the owner.
16. The visitor agrees not to employ or engage any contractors to work on the vessel at the RYCT Marina or mooring unless said contractors provide suitable proof of insurance coverage and are licensed and approved by the RYCT Bosun Office prior to any maintenance being conducted.
17. The visitor shall not bring any fuel or hazardous materials into the marina.
18. Diving, fishing or cleaning of fish is not permitted in the Marina.
19. The RYCT may at its discretion, board, inspect move the vessel and/or its equipment to any marina berth, hardstand or mooring at the visitor's risk and expense. If circumstances permit the RYCT will endeavour to notify the owner of its intentions in this regard.
20. The visitor agrees to comply with and obey any reasonable direction given to it by the RYCT, its General Manager or its duly authorised employees.
