75th Tasports Maria Island Race

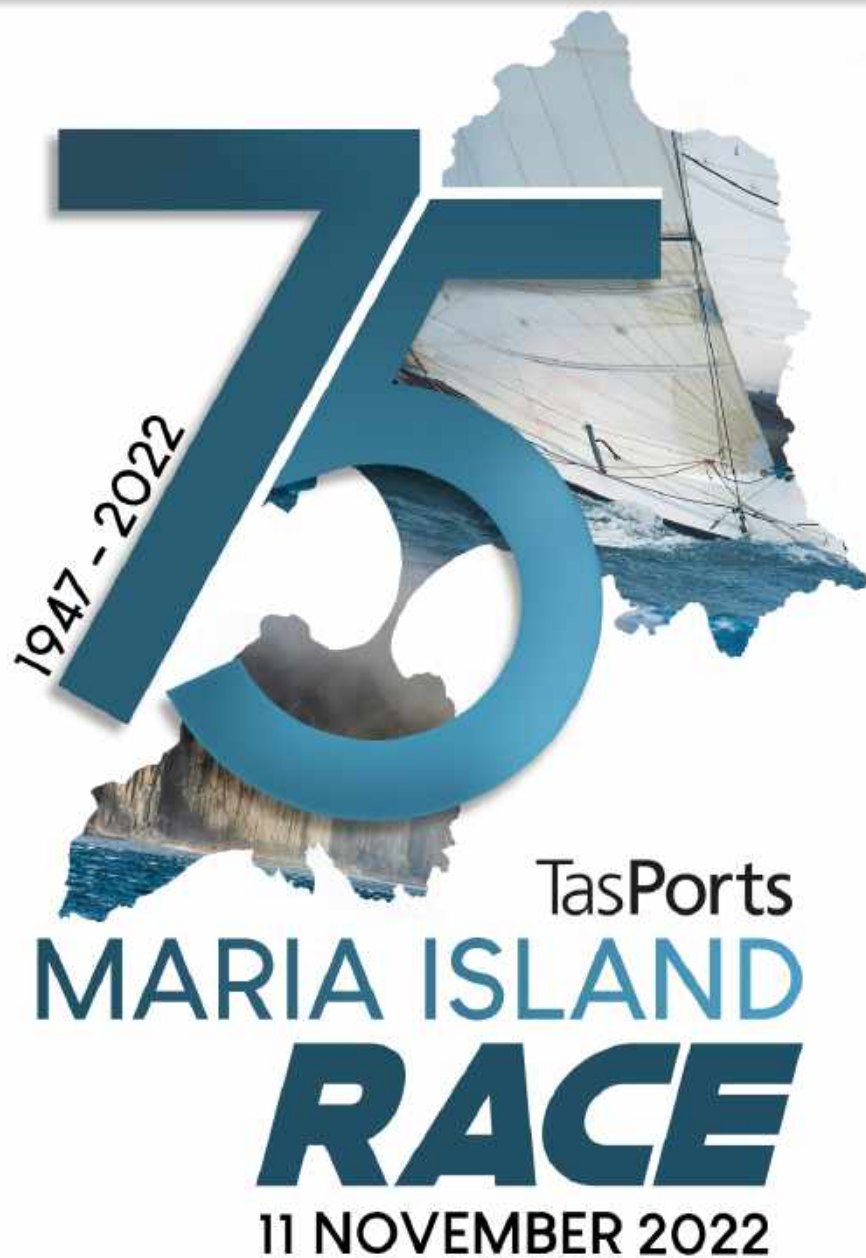
Tomorrow we embark on the 75th Anniversary of the iconic Tasports Maria Island Race.

We hope you enjoy Tasmanian Yachtsman 2022 and support the organisations and businesses which support us.

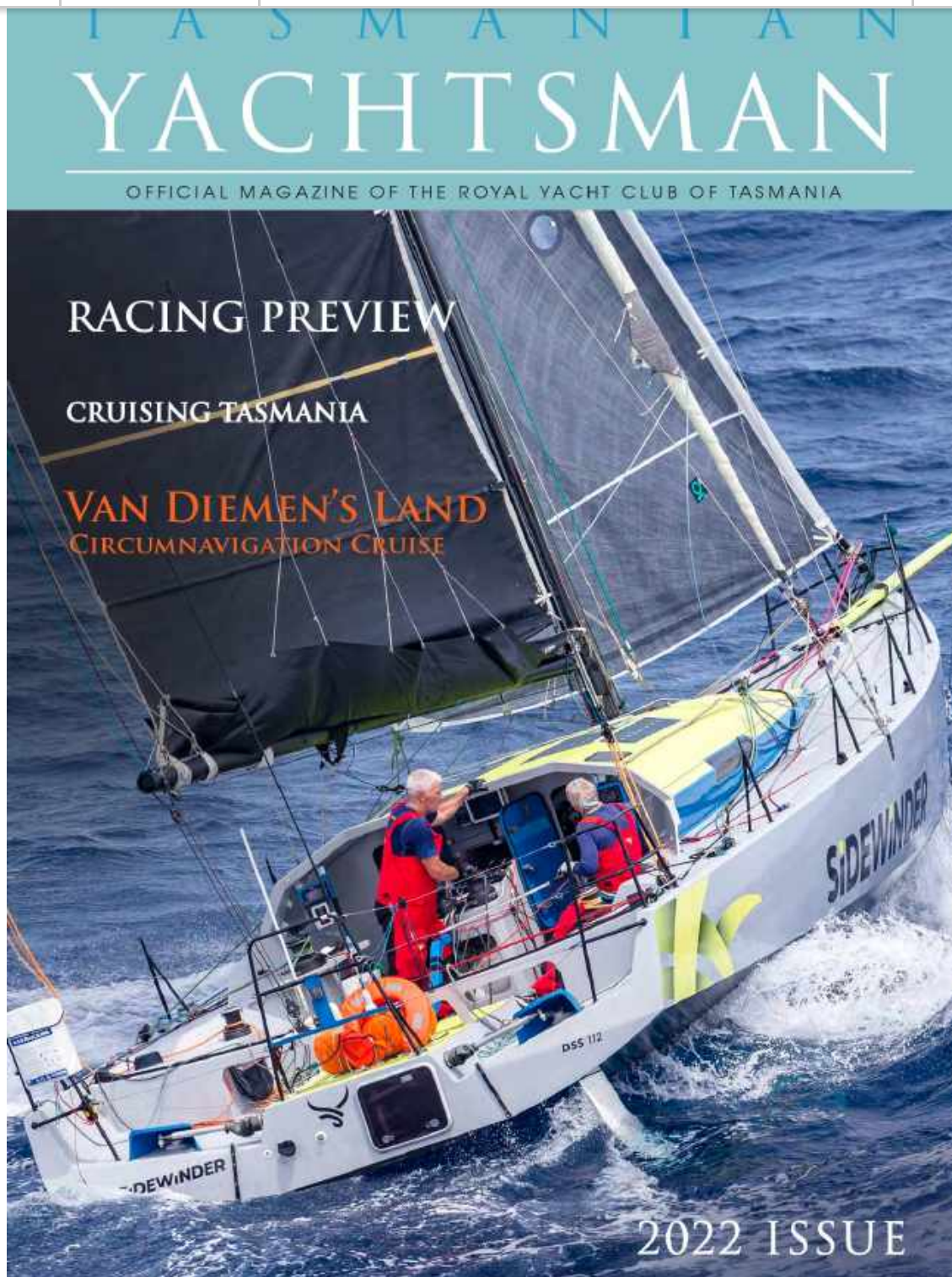
