1 RULES

All races will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

All competitors shall be members of RYCT or any club affiliated with Australian Sailing. All entries for the series shall be via the online entry accompanied by the prescribed fee and be lodged with the Organising Authority by 1600 hours on Friday 5 May. Casual entries for individual races of the series must be lodged with the Race Committee by 0930 hours on the day of the race.

The entry fee for the series will be \$70. The entry fee for individual race days will be \$20.

7 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the Derwent River between Battery Point and Long Point.

8 COURSES

9 SCORING

Each day of racing shall be scored individually, with Low Point Scoring applied to the race or races on the day.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be at the discretion of RYCT OTB and will be awarded at the end of each day of sailing. A series prize will be awarded to the winners of classes with more than five starters in 75% of races.

11 ENTRY DISCLAIMER

It is the competitor's decision to enter an event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an event is at their exclusive risk in every respect.
