MARINA REDEVELOPMENT

We are excited to announce the upcoming redevelopment of A-Arm, which is set to begin in the second week of June. The marina redevelopment will see improvements to the aging infrastructure on A-arm to better meet the needs of users.

Please be aware that we anticipate disruption to power and water services for approximately two days. The exact dates of these disruptions will be confirmed and communicated to all members as soon as possible. Additionally, there will be restricted access to the marina during the redevelopment, and we will provide further information on the exact restrictions and dates as they become available.

During this time, safety is our number one priority. We ask that all members and visitors exercise caution around worksites and follow all safety directives. Safety is everybody's responsibility.

The next site meeting is scheduled for late May and we will continue to provide ongoing updates and progress reports on the redevelopment of A-Arm via our website, newsletters, and social media platforms.

‘Test and Tag’ of power leads

Marina staff will soon undertake a routine check across the marina to ensure ‘test and tag’ of all power leads has been completed.

It is a requirement that your leads must be tested and tagged (as pictured below) by an electrician or certified person every 12 months. If your lead is identified as not meeting the minimum safety standards, we will contact you and disconnect the lead to avert safety issues.



Test and tagging must be completed by end of June 2023.

Stop the prop – propped open gates present a security risk

A reminder to keep the marina gate closed at all times. Propping open the gate with rope may be convenient, but it gives outside threats easy access to your boat.

If you see an maintenance issue on the marina, tell us!
