- 5. We agree that if we ask for assistance at any time during the cruise and such assistance as is available is afforded us, we will accept full responsibility for any resulting financial costs.
- 6. All equipment required to be kept on the vessel by Marine & Safety Tasmania supplemented by equipment listed in the Safety Compliance Check List for this event functions properly, is readily accessible, and is of a type, size and capacity suitable and adequate for this cruise.
- 7. The safety equipment on the vessel is adequate, properly maintained and stowed and we know where the equipment is kept, and how to use it.
- 8. We confirm that the combined experience of the crew continues to conform with the minimum requirements specified in section 3 of Cruise Safety Requirements
