LOCAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. APPLICABLE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1 The Sailing Instructions for this event, as required by RRS 90.2, are constituted by these Local Sailing Instructions in conjunction with the 2K Standard Sailing Instructions (Version: 2023) which are available on the 2K Team Racing website (www.2Kteamracing.com).
- 1.2 The bylaws of The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania that apply to all participants will be published on the official notice board. The national regulations (when applicable) will be available for inspection at the race office.

2. AMENDMENTS TO THE STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Further to SSI C3.6: For signalling a protest under RRS D2.2 (a) (Protests by Boats) a code flag Yankee shall be used.
- 2.2 Wherever stated, flag and fleet colours 'Red, Yellow and/or Blue' is replaced by 'Pink, Yellow and/or Blue'.
- 2.3 SSI 10.3 '... as required by SSI 11.1.' is amended to read 'as required by SSI 10.1.'
- 2.4 SSI C3.9 is deleted.

3. BOATS AND SAILS

- 3.1 Further to SSI 3.1: Boats will be identified by bow number.
- 3.2 Boats will be equipped with the items as detailed in Addendum G.

4. EVENT PROGRAMME, EVENT FORMAT AND STARTING SCHEDULES

- 4.1 A list of eligible teams and the starting schedules are detailed in LSI Addendum E.
- 4.2 The event programme and event format are detailed in LSI Addendum F.

5. MARKS / STARTING AND FINISHING LINE

- 5.1 Further to SSI 6.1: Description of Marks

Marks 1, 2 & 3 will be orange inflatables. The start/finish mark will be a black & white chequered inflatable. The RC boat will be the white powercat *Masterpiece*.

EVENT PROGRAMME and FORMAT

F1. EVENT PROGRAM

F1.1 Racing Program

Sat 20 April 2024 (1st racing day)

Registration at RYCT Clubhouse from 08:30 to 09:00.

Skippers briefing (mandatory) at 09:00.

First warning signal no earlier than 10:00.

Sunday 21 April 2024 (2nd racing day)

Skippers briefing if required at 09:00.

First warning signal 10:00.

The last warning signal on the last day of racing will be approximately 15:30.

F1.2 Social Programme

Post-sailing barbecue on Saturday and Sunday.

EVENT FORMAT

F1.3 Stage One:

Teams shall sail a series of round robins until one hour before the time of the last warning signal on the final day. On conclusion of Stage One teams shall be placed in rank order using SSI Addendum H.

F1.4 Stage Two:

A Knockout series shall be sailed between the first and second ranked teams from Stage One. The winner of Stage Two shall be the first team to score two race wins, the other team shall be ranked second.

The other teams will be ranked using the results of stage one.

	Major damage or new capping – full cost of repair up to	\$ 500.00

Sail damage	Rips smaller than 10cm	\$ 200.00
	Rips larger than 10cm up to 40cm	\$ 300.00
	Rips larger than 40cm – full cost of repair up to	\$ 500.00
	Sail write off – full cost of replacement up to	\$ 500.00
Flags	Loss	\$ 200.00
Sheets	Damage or loss (per sheet)	\$ 50.00
Deck fitting	Damage or loss - full cost of replacement up to	\$ 200.00
Hatches	Minor damage	\$ 100.00

Radios	Loss	\$350
Buoyancy aids	Loss	\$150
Tiller extension	Break	\$100
