FACILITIES & SERVICES

The RYCT has one of the most modern boat berthing facilities in Hobart catering to all vessels up to 20 metres.

- Floating and fixed berths (vessels up to 20m)
- Boat yard, bosun support, hard stand & trailer parking
- Fuel: Diesel & ULP
- Moorings and trailer-boat launching facilities
- Shed storage & lockers
- Discover Sailing Training Centre & junior sailing programs
- Year-round racing & social calendar
- Function rooms for 400+ guests
- Bar & Bistro, regular social events
- Showers, laundry & visitor amenities

The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania is located only a few minutes' drive from the centre of Hobart, the Hobart Waterfront and Salamanca. The Club is fully licensed and open seven days a week. BOATING VISITORS

MARINA

For those visiting by boat The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania houses both floating and fixed pile marina berths from 10 to 20+ metres with power and water facilities. Due to the high demand for marina berths over the summer months we recommend that visitors book early to ensure the availability of a marina berth for your stay in Hobart.

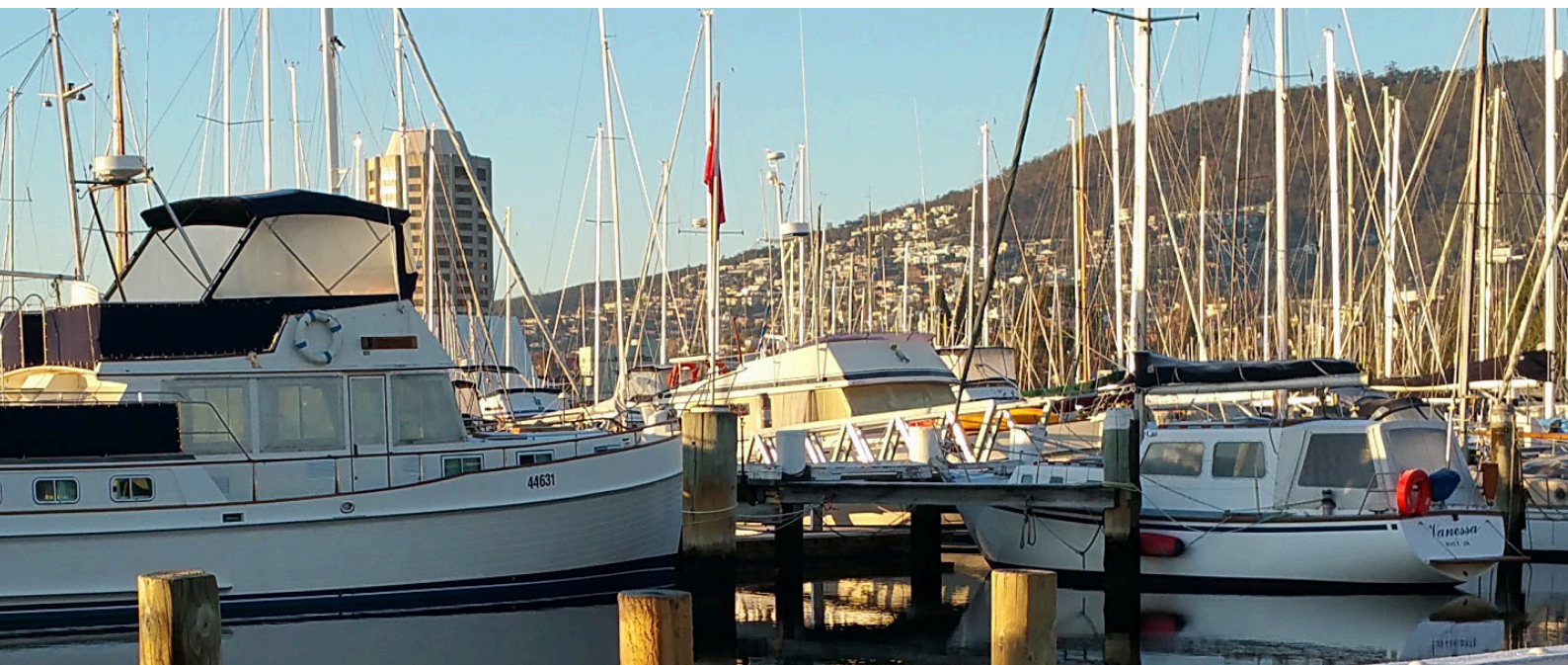

BOAT YARD

At the RYCT, we take pride in offering a friendly, professional service for all your boat slipping requirements.

- All vessel up to 50ft and 20 tonnes
- Open 5 days
- Access to large range of qualified trade contractors to suit requirements

The Club has 24 hour access to diesel and unleaded fuel available on the south-west of the Marina on our dedicated fuel dock. Credit Card facility is located on the dock for payment.



The RYCT has Wifi access for guests of the club which extends to sections of the Marina. Password is available upon request.



The RYCT has shower and toilet facilities as well as coin operated washing and drying machines for guest use.



Recycling & Waste Management

We are committed to responsible waste management. Recycling and general waste bins are conveniently located near the main Marina entrance.

Dedicated disposal facilities are available in the slipyard for items such as oil, oily rags, and batteries. Please see our staff for assistance.

Please note: gas cylinders, fuel, paint, hazardous chemicals, and bulk waste are strictly prohibited from disposal on site.



CCTV

For the safety and security of our members, visitors, and their vessels, the Marina is monitored by an extensive CCTV surveillance system.

Coverage includes the clubhouse, marina, car park, slipyard, and surrounding grounds. This system is in place to help ensure a safe and welcoming environment for all.



Access

Access to the marina and amenities block is available to members. Contractors, and visiting yachts must check-in at the front office during office hours or ahead of time if outside office hours for access.

If you are expecting guests, please meet them at the gate to welcome them in. For everyone's security, access passes are for individual use only.



Visitor Parking

The club offers limited parking for visitors on the left hand side as you drive into the facility.

Situated at the start of the marina, within designated bays, courtesy wheelbarrows are at your disposal.

In the spirit of maintaining order and consideration, we kindly request that visitors return wheelbarrows to their designated areas post-use.

THE RIVER DERWENT

The estuary of the River Derwent forms the harbour of the city of Hobart, one of the deepest sheltered harbours in the world. Boating activity on the Derwent, along with that on all waters in Tasmania not covered by Commonwealth legislation is managed by Marine and Safety Tasmania (MAST). 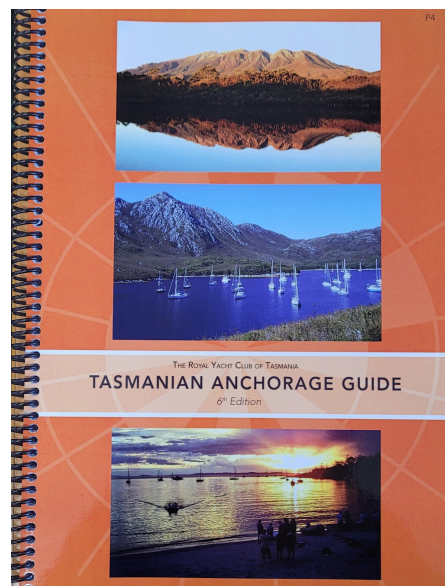
VESSEL SEWAGE PUMP OUT

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Thank you for visiting The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania.

To ensure the safe and enjoyable use of our facilities, all guests are required to comply with the RYCT's berthing terms and conditions, as outlined below:

Booking & Payment

- All berthing fees must be paid in advance at the time of booking.
- Applications will only be confirmed once payment and a fully completed, signed application form have been received.

Berth Allocation & Cancellations

- The RYCT reserves the right to change the allocated casual berth at any time, before or during the booking.
- A minimum of 7 days' written notice is required to cancel or shorten a booking. Notice must be sent to ryct.marina@ryct.org.au. Refunds will not be issued if this requirement is not met.

Berthing Charges

- Fees are based on the **overall length of the allocated berth**, which includes the vessel and any extensions such as dinghies, davits, bowsprits, poles or marlin boards.
- Power may be charged on a cost-recovery basis.

Berthing Rules

- Bowsprits, anchors and davits must not overhang walkways, arms or fingers.
- Loose ropes or lines must not float in fairways or obstruct berths.
- Electrical leads must be tested, tagged, and kept tidy (please use the built-in cable channels).
- Dinghies must be stored onboard and not left in the water or at berths unless a designated area is provided (charges may apply).



Vessel Requirements

- All boats must be registered and carry insurance with a minimum of \$10 million public liability. Proof of insurance must be provided before arrival.
- The vessel must be seaworthy and equipped with suitable mooring lines and strong points.

Environmental & Safety Requirements

- Discharge of toilets, oils, chemicals, spirits, inflammables or oily bilges into the water is strictly prohibited.
- No sanding, grinding, painting, hot work or other maintenance (except minor works) may be carried out on the marina.
- Diving, fishing and fish cleaning are not permitted.
- Rubbish must be removed from the marina or kept on board. Bins are available in the boat yard.
- The marina is a no wash zone. Speed limits must be observed when approaching, departing, or within the marina.

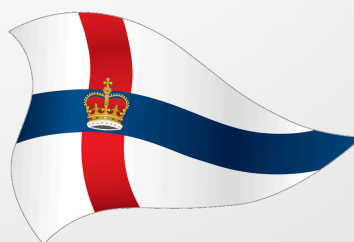
Conduct & Responsibility

- Boat owners must not cause undue noise or disturbance.
- Any collision or damage to the marina or other vessels must be reported to the RYCT Manager within 24 hours.
- The RYCT accepts no responsibility for the safety of any vessel, person, or property. Vessels are moored entirely at the owner's risk.
- Owners agree to indemnify the RYCT against any liability arising from or connected with their vessel.
- All directions given by the RYCT Manager or their delegate must be followed at all times.
